Today, the accused appeared before me. He voluntarily pleaded guilty by filing application voluntarily to that effect. I have personally verified this fact from him. As such, he appears to have voluntarily pleading guilty and hence, it is accepted. He submitted that he is the only bread earner for his family, is poor and prayed for leniency. Considering his submissions and the nature of offence, I pass the following order :-

The accused is convicted under section 252 of the Criminal Procedure Code, 1973 on his voluntarily pleading guilty for the offence punishable u/Sec. 7(2) r/w. 20(2) of The Cigarettes and Other Tobacco Products (Prohibition of advertisement and regulation of trade and commerce, production, supply and distribution) Act, 2003. He is sentenced to pay fine of Rs. 500/-, in default, to suffer simple imprisonment for 1 day.
