The application for bail for the above named accused petitioner U/s.483 of BNSS is taken up for hearing.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the accused petitioner and the Ld. P.P., Murshidabad.

It is submitted for the accused petitioner that the alleged victim had consensual relationship with the present accused and the accused has been implicated in this case on false allegation.

It is also submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the accused petitioner that no such application for bail on the selfsame cause of action has been filed or rejected by Hon'ble Court, to which the Ld. P.P. expressed his agreement.

Ld. P.P., Murshidabad opposed the prayer for bail.

Perused the T.C.R. and the C.D.

On careful perusal of the F.I.R. and other documents such as statement of the victim lady U/s.180 of BNSS as well as 183 of BNSS, it appears that the victim is a married lady and she had consensual relationship with the present accused petitioner.

Considering the nature of allegation made and the materials appearing in C.D., particularly the statement of the victim lady U/s.183 of BNSS and the period of detention of the accused petitioner in custody since **08.02.2026**, I am of the opinion that the further custodial detention of the accused is not required for the purpose of investigation.

Accordingly, the prayer of the petitioner for bail U/s.483 BNSS stands **allowed**.

Hence, the above named petitioner in connection with above noted P.S. case, with regard to the incident complained of, shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.5000/- with two sureties of Rs.2,500/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the Ld. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Murshidabad.

The Crl. Misc. case is thus disposed of.
