**Order No. 2 dated 05.03.2026**

The application for bail for the above named accused petitioners U/s.483 of BNSS is taken up for hearing.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the accused petitioners and the Ld. P.P., Murshidabad.

Ld. Defence Advocate prays for bail on the ground that some other co-accused persons have been granted bail and the present accused petitioners surrendered before the Court and are in custody for a considerable period of time.

It is also submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the accused petitioners that no such application for bail on the selfsame cause of action has been filed or rejected by Hon'ble Court, to which the Ld. P.P. expressed his agreement.

Ld. P.P., Murshidabad has raised objection to the prayer for bail.

Perused the materials in case record and the C.D.

Considered the nature of allegation made in the F.I.R., statement of witnesses including that of the injured victim U/s.180 of BNSS, Seizure list, the Medical documents etc. as available in the C.D.

It also appears that other co-accused persons including the alleged principal accused, have already been granted bail by this Court vide order No.3 dated 14.08.2025 in Crl. Misc. case No.**4519/2025**, order No.2 dated 17.07.2025 in Crl. Misc. case No.**3986/2025**, order No.2 dated 06.08.2025 in Crl. Misc. case No. **4448/2025**, order dated 13.01.2026 in Crl. Misc. case No.**49/2026**, order dated 13.01.2026 in Crl. Misc. case No.**76/2026** etc.

Considering all these facts and circumstances of the case and also keeping in mind the period of detention of the accused in custody since their surrender on **18.02.2026**, I am of the view that further detention of the present accused petitioner in custody will not serve any fruitful purpose.

Accordingly, the prayer for bail U/s.483 BNSS stands **allowed**.

Hence, the above named petitioner, in connection with above noted P.S. case, shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.5000/- with two sureties of Rs.2,500/- each, subject to the satisfaction of Ld. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Murshidabad.

The Crl. Misc. case is thus disposed of.
