**Order No.2 dated 05.03.2026**

The application for bail for the above named accused petitioner U/s.483 of BNSS is taken up for hearing.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the accused petitioner and the Ld. P.P., Murshidabad.

Ld. Defence Advocate prays for bail on the ground that the present accused petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case.

It is also submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the accused petitioner that no such application for bail on the selfsame cause of action has been filed or rejected by Hon'ble Court, to which the Ld. P.P. expressed his agreement.

Ld. P.P., Murshidabad has raised objection to the prayer for bail.

Perused the materials in case record and the C.D.

I have gone through the F.I.R. and the statement of witnesses including that of the alleged injured victim U/s.180 of BNSS.

Injury report reveals grievous injury.

However, on careful perusal of the F.I.R. and the statement of the witnesses U/s.180 of BNSS it appears that there is no specific allegation against the present accused petitioner for commission of alleged offence.

Considering the nature of allegation made, materials in C.D. and the extent of involvement of the present accused petitioner in commission of alleged offence and also considering the period of his detention in custody since **23.02.2026**, I am of the view that if the accused is enlarged on bail, the same will not be prejudicial to the prosecution.

Accordingly, the prayer for bail U/s.483 BNSS stands **allowed**.

Hence, the above named petitioner, in connection with above noted P.S. case, shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.5000/- with two sureties of Rs.2,500/- each, subject to the satisfaction of Ld. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Murshidabad.

The Crl. Misc. case is thus disposed of.
