The application for bail for the above named accused petitioner U/s.483 of BNSS is taken up for hearing.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the accused petitioner and the Ld. P.P., Murshidabad.

It is submitted for the accused petitioner is in custody for a considerable period of time and due to his absence, there is none to look after his ailing child.

It is also submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the accused petitioner that no such application for bail on the selfsame cause of action has been filed or rejected by Hon'ble Court, to which the Ld. P.P. expressed his agreement.

Ld. P.P., Murshidabad vehemently opposed the prayer for bail by drawing the attention of this Court to the Medical documents, available in C.D.

Perused the F.I.R. and other materials in C.D.

The present accused petitioner is the husband of the alleged victim lady and their marriage was solemnized 5 years ago.

The allegation made in the F.I.R. is that after marriage the victim lady was subjected to physical and mental torture and she was administered acid forcefully.

I have gone through the statement of the witnesses including that of the injured victim U/s.180 of BNSS in consultation with the Medical documents i.e. Injury report.

Considering the serious nature of allegation made and the materials available on record and also considering the involvement of the accused petitioner in commission of alleged offence and also taking into account the fact that after rejection of prayer for bail by this Court only **on 06.02.2026 in Crl. Misc. case No.251/2026**, no new ground is forthcoming to enlarge the accused petitioner on bail.

Accordingly, the prayer for bail U/s.483 BNSS stands **rejected** at this stage.

The Crl. Misc. case is thus disposed of.
