**Order No.2 dated 05.03.2026**

The application for bail for the above named accused petitioner U/s.483 of BNSS is taken up for hearing.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the accused petitioner and the Ld. P.P., Murshidabad.

It is also submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the accused petitioner that no such application for bail on the selfsame cause of action has been filed or rejected by Hon'ble Court, to which the Ld. P.P. expressed his agreement.

Ld. P.P., Murshidabad opposed the prayer for bail. However, he has submitted that the accused petitioner was arrested subsequently and nothing was recovered from his possession.

Perused the materials in case record and the C.D.

In this case, the search and seizure have already been over, as it appears from the Seizure list, available with the C.D. The present accused petitioner is languishing in custody since 04.02.2026.

Considering the nature of allegation made and materials in C.D. and also keeping in mind the period of detention of the accused in custody since **04.02.2026** and the fact that other co-accused persons are on bail, I am of the opinion that further detention of the accused petitioner in custody will not serve any fruitful purpose.

Accordingly, the prayer for bail U/s.483 BNSS stands **allowed**.

Hence, the above named petitioner, in connection with above noted P.S. case, shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.5000/- with two sureties of Rs.2,500/- each, subject to the satisfaction of Ld. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Murshidabad.

The Crl. Misc. case is thus disposed of.
