The application for bail for the above named accused petitioner U/s.483 of BNSS is taken up for hearing.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the accused petitioner and the Ld. P.P. Murshidabad.

It is also submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the accused petitioner that no such application for bail on the selfsame cause of action has been filed or rejected by Hon'ble Court, to which the Ld. P.P. expressed his agreement.

Ld. P.P., Murshidabad has opposed the prayer for bail.

Perused the materials in case record and the C.D.

On perusal of the C.D. including the seizure list it appears that one iron made fire arms including some Fake Indian Currency Notes of denomination of Rs. 500/- have been recovered from the possession of this accused person.

Considering the nature of offence alleged, I find that there are sufficient prima facie incriminating materials against the present accused petitioner for commission of alleged offence and as C.S. has not yet been submitted and also investigation is going on, I am of the opinion that this is not a fit case to enlarge the accused petitioner on bail.

Accordingly, the prayer for bail stands **rejected**.

The Crl. Misc. Case is thus disposed of.
