Order No.03 dated 17.04.2026

The application for anticipatory bail U/s.482 of BNSS, filed by the petitioners as named above is taken up for hearing.

Heard the Ld. lawyer for the petitioners and the Ld. P.P., Murshidabad.

Ld. Advocate for the accused petitioners submits that out of rivalry, the F.I.R. has been lodged with false allegation. He also submits that out of 7 accused persons, 4 accused have already been granted bail.

It is also submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the petitioners that no such application for bail on the selfsame cause of action has ever been filed before or rejected by the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta, to which, the Ld. P.P. expressed his agreement.

Ld. P.P., Murshidabad submits that the accused persons allegedly hurled bombs at the house of the complainant to pressurize them to withdraw the earlier case, initiated by the complainant.

Perused the T.C.R. and the Case Diary.

It is found that 3 accused persons were granted bail on 10.03.2026 and on the same date, one of the accused persons was granted anticipatory bail by this Court.

It appears that in the alleged bomb hurling no one was injured.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case and the materials on record, I am inclined to allow the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail stands **allowed**.

Accordingly, in the event of arrest of the petitioners as named above in c/w the above noted P.S. case, they shall be released on furnishing bail bond of Rs.5,000/- each with two sureties of Rs.2,500/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the arresting officer on condition to meet with the I.O. **once in a week** till completion of investigation.

If released on bail, the petitioners are directed to comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 482(2) of BNSS.

Return the T.C.R. and the C.D.

The Crl. Misc. Case is thus disposed of.
