ORDER

1. This order of mine shall dispose of anticipatory bail application filed by the accused/applicants in the case mentioned above.

2. Notice of the bail application was issued to the state and Sh.Baljit Singh, learned APP appeared on behalf of the State. Today Sh.J.S.Kalra, Advocate has appeared and filed power of attorney on behalf of complainant. The concerned Ahlmad has reported that as per

CIS system, this is first anticipatory bail application of applicants/accused. No other bail application of application is pending or decided in the present FIR in the Hon'ble High Court as well as Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. On 08.05.2026 ASI Gurmeet Singh No.1497/FZR, P.S.City Ferozepur has produced the record of investigation and suffered statement that this is first bail application of applicant and no other bail application is pending or decided by any other Court including Hon'ble High Court. There is no other FIR's is registered against the accused. The custodial interrogation of accused is required in this case.

3. Learned counsel for applicant/accused has argued that applicant-accused is innocent and he has been falsely implicated in the present case. He further contended that there is un-considerable delay in lodging the present FIR as alleged occurrence is of dated 17.01.2026 at about 07:00/07:30PM and the present FIR was registered on 19.01.2026 at about 02:48AM which was not explained by the complainant in his statement. Infact the real story of registration of the present FIR are that complainant want to install mobile tower in his property which was situated in the colony and the same was opposed by the near locality regarding that the number of persons moved applications to the authority but the complainant party create hindrance

and want to install tower forcibly. In the present alleged occurrence happened in the area of Ferozepur City and multi-specialty and renowned hospital but the complainant himself admitted in the PHC Mamdot instead of Civil Hospital Ferozepur so far distance about 25 KM, only because the reason that son of complainant namely Preet Mukhija is posted at Civil Hospital Mamdot as doctor and he help him out to strong the case of prosecution. As per allegations, applicant/accused is empty handed and there is no specific allegations/overact attributed to the applicant/accused. It is cross-version case and co-accused/non-applicant namely Gurpritam Singh was also received injuries at the hand of the complainant party which was not explained by the prosecution. The interim bail of co-accused was granted by the Hon'ble High Court. Applicant undertakes to cooperate the police during the course of investigation. Lastly, he prayed that the applicant/accused be released on anticipatory bail.

4. On the other hand, learned APP for the state assisted by learned counsel for complainant has strongly opposed the bail application and argued that the applicant/accused has committed the serious offences and custodial interrogation of the applicant/accused is

required and as such, he is not entitled for concession of anticipatory bail. Hence, he prayed for dismissal of the present bail application.

5. I have heard the learned counsel for the applicants/accused, learned APP for the State and have gone through the police record, minutely.

6. A perusal of the file, it shows that FIR has been registered on the statement of complainant Natinder Kumar son of Thakur Dass with the allegations that he is a businessman and has purchased 4 marla of plot from Gurpritam Singh about 2 years ago where he has constructed showroom. Gurpritam Singh and his family were jealous from complainant. On 17.01.2026 at about 7.00/7.30 PM, he has parked his car in front of his showroom, upon which Kulwinder Kaur, Navdeep Kaur, Jasmeen came out of their house and started arguing with him as to why he has parked his car outside in street and asked him to park his car inside. He told them that he has parked his car by the side of wall of the showroom and had gone inside his showroom. Thereafter, Harman Singh armed with a kappa entered in his showroom and gave blow of kappa to him, which hit on his left leg. He raised an alarm, which attracted his Avish Mukhiza and one employee namely Arsha Chahal. Then, Gurpritam Singh and some other persons

also entered and started damaging the showroom and blow of iron rod on the person of Avish, which hit on the right side of his head. They also manhandled their employee Arsha and torn her cloth. Then, he in order to save himself started running towards their house. When they reached at chowk at some distance then Harman Singh, Gurpritam Singh, Malkeet Singh, Amandeep Singh, Sukh Kamboj and 6-7 unidentified persons came there and Gurpritam Singh gave blow of iron rod, which hit on the left side of his head. Amandeep gave blow of iron rod to him, which hit on the front side of his head. He fell on the ground and then Malkeet Singh gave blow of baseball bat, which hit on the left side of his chest. Then, Sukh Kamboj gave blow of kappa from reverse side, which hit on his right hand. Then 6/7 unknown persons also gave blow of Daangs and Sottas on his person, which hit on various parts of his body. People from the surrounding also started gathering at the spot and Kanta Mukhija wife of the complainant also came at the spot. All accused also scuffled with his wife and tore her clothes. Then, Malkeet Singh took out pistol from his waist and tried to cock the same with intention to kill the complainant and then all accused fled away from the spot. The accused also took away his gold chain and watch. He was taken to Civil Hospital Ferozepur for

treatment, but, all accused were already standing outside Civil Hospital Ferozepur, due to which complainant was shifted to Civil Hospital Mamdot, from where he got treatment.

7. The main contention of the learned counsel for the applicant/accused is that the incident took place at City Ferozepur whereas the complainant got his medical conducted at Civil Hospital, Mamdot which is 25 k.m. away from Ferozepur as the son of the complainant is practicing as a doctor there. Further, the FIR has been registered after a delay of 2 days of the occurrence but the said contention of learned counsel for applicant/accused is a matter of evidence. Further, this Court is of the view that the name of the applicant/accused has been specifically mentioned in the FIR. Further Specific role has been attributed to him. The allegations against the applicant-accused that he alongwith non-applicants/co-accused being member of unlawful assembly caused injuries to complainant. Further there are specific allegation against applicant/accused that he gave blow of kappa from reverse side, which hit on the right hand of complainant. So, the allegations against the applicant/accused are serious in nature. Moreover, as per version of Investigating Officer, custodial interrogation of applicants/accused is required. So, keeping in

view the seriousness and gravity of the offence and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Court finds that no ground is made out to grant anticipatory bail to the applicant/accused, as the custodial interrogation is necessary to unravel the truth.

8. Hence, in view of my above said discussion, the present applicant/accused does not deserve the concession of anticipatory bail. Accordingly, the present bail application filed by the applicant-accused for grant of anticipatory bail is hereby stands dismissed.

9. Police file be returned. Papers be tagged with the main file or be consigned.
