The application for bail U/s.483 BNSS filed by the petitioners as named above is taken up for hearing.

Ld. Advocate for the accused petitioner submits that the present accused petitioners are in custody since 07.05.2026 and considering the same, they may be granted bail.

It is also submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the petitioners that no such application for bail on the selfsame cause of action has ever been filed before or rejected by the Hon'ble Court, Calcutta or by this Court, to which the Ld. P.P. expressed his agreement.

Ld. P.P., Murshidabad has cited statement of the injured, as available in C.D at page No. 55 and Injury reports at page Nos. 99 and 101 of the CD.

Perused the FIR and other materials in the C.D.

By combining the statement of the injured as cited by Ld. PP at page No. 55 of the CD and the FIR, principally, considering whose name transpires from the statement of the injured/victim and also considering the period of detention already undergone by accused petitioners, the bail prayer stands **allowed**.

The accused petitioners as named above in c/w the above noted P.S. case, shall be released on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- each with two sureties of Rs. 5,000/- each, one of which must be local, subject to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Murshidabad on condition to meet with the I.O. **once in a week** till completion of investigation.

The Crl. Misc. Case is thus disposed of.
