The application for anticipatory bail U/s.482 BNSS filed by the petitioner as named above is taken up for hearing.

It is submitted for the accused petitioner that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and considering the same, the petitioner may be granted anticipatory bail.

It is also submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner that no such application for bail on the selfsame cause of action has ever been filed before or rejected by the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta or by this Court, to which, the Ld. P.P. expressed his agreement.

Ld. P.P., Murshidabad has cited page **No.18, 19, 20, 29, 36, 37, 39** of the C.D.

Perused the FIR and the materials gathered in the C.D.

Considered the F.I.R., lodged by the defacto complainant herself.

Also considered the statement of the victim lady U/s.180 of BNSS as well as U/s.183 of BNSS, as cited by the Ld. P.P., Murshidabad, available at C.D. page **No.39, 36, 37** respectively, including the Medical documents at page **No.18, 19 and 20** of the C.D.

Considering the nature of allegation made including the statement of the victim lady U/s.183 of BNSS and other materials gathered, it appears to me that custodial detention of the present accused petitioner will not serve any substantial purpose.

Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail stands **allowed**.

Accordingly, in the event of arrest of the petitioner as named above in c/w the above noted P.S. case, he shall be released on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of Rs.5,000/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the arresting officer on condition to meet with the I.O. **once in a week** till completion of investigation.

If released on bail, the petitioner is directed to comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 482(2) of BNSS.

The Crl. Misc. Case is thus disposed of.
