Received a copy of Order dated 26.06.2025 passed by the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta in C.R.M.(NDPS) No. 456 of 2025 vide Memo No.:- 3892-Cr dated 02.08.2025 in respect of accused person, namely, Sentu Seikh and the Hon'ble High Court has been pleased enough to pass an order as follows:-

“Having heard the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the parties and also in view of materials available so far in the record, I find that rigour of section 37 of the NDPS Act, clearly attracts against the present petitioner in this case and as such the prayer for bail is considered and **rejected**.

However, trial court is directed to expedite the trial and if required by splitting the record in respect of the absconding accused, he will proceed with the trial to reach a reasonable conclusion at the earliest.”
