

BA CIS No.1411 of 2019 Abid Basir Vs. State of Punjab

ORDER

File put up before the undersigned being Vacation Judge.

This order shall dispose of an application filed by the applicant Abid Basir for grant of regular bail in case F.I.R. No. 6 dated 28.05.2019 under Section 420/419/471/120-B of IPC, registered at Police Station Airport Mohali.

2. It has been averred in the application that the applicant was arrested on 28.5.2019. He has been falsely implicated in the present case. Nothing was recovered from the applicant. Challan has not been presented so far. The applicant is ready and willing to furnish the bail bonds. The applicant undertakes to appear before the trial Court on each and every date of hearing. The applicant will not tamper with the investigation.

3. As per allegations, a complaint was received from the Airport that one person was travelling on flight No.6E-372-IXC-SXR. It was booked on the name of Mr. Umar Firdaus and passenger reported with aadhar card with the same name. However, counter staff found something suspicious regarding tempering of aadhar card. The matter was reported to the Manager. Later it was found that it was a wrong aadhar card which is not updated with UIDAI portal and the actual name of the passenger is Abid Bashir.

4. Despite arrest of the applicant from 28.5.2019, the prosecution has not been able to tell the motive behind the same. The Investigating Officer has not been able to conclude as to why he has done so and wanted to travel under wrong name and identity. Since he has been sent to judicial custody on the request of the prosecution itself, therefore, he is not required for any purpose. The allegations levelled by the prosecution are matter of trial. As such, no useful purpose will be served by keeping the applicant further in custody for indefinite period, rather, it will be extra ordinary burden. Hence, the bail application is allowed and applicant is admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bond in the sum of

Rs.1,00,000/- with one surety each in the like amount, with the following conditions:-

- I) That he will appear on each and every date of hearing in the Court, till the disposal of this case.*
- ii) That he will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court,*
- iii) That he will not win over the witnesses of the prosecution of this case.*

Police record be returned. Copy of this order be provided to the counsel for the applicant enabling the applicant to furnish bonds before learned Area/Duty Magistrate for information. File be consigned to the record room.
