

Sukhjit Singh @ Sukha Vs. State of Punjab

Heard on the bail application moved on behalf of applicant-accused Sukhjit Singh @ Sukha.

Ld. counsel for applicant-accused has averred that no case is made out against the accused and he has committed no such offence and has been falsely implicated. That investigation in the above case has been completed. The trial will take long time and by keeping the accused/applicant behind the bar will not serve any purpose. That the accused/applicant will abide by all the terms and conditions imposed by the Hon'ble Court and will appear on each and every date fixed in this court. It is argued that the accused is in judicial custody since long and is no more required for investigation. As such, application be allowed.

Notice of the bail application was given to the ld. APP who orally opposed the bail application but did not file any written reply.

After hearing contentions of the APP as well as counsel for accused-applicant, it is clear that the offences which are alleged to have been committed by the accused are under section 452, 323, 324, 354 IPC. The offences committed by the accused are serious in nature and pose gigantic threat to the society at large. Hence, keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and gravity of the offences, the accused-applicant does not deserve the concession of bail. Hence, the bail application filed by applicant-accused is hereby dismissed without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case.
