ORDER

1. Present bail application has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C on behalf of accused-applicant for grant of regular bail in the aforesaid FIR. Notice of the application was given to State and record of the case was produced.
2. I have heard learned counsel for accused/applicant, learned Additional P.P for the State and have carefully perused the record with their able assistance.
3. Brief facts of the case are that on 02.08.2020 in the area of

R.K.M.Society, Chunni – Landran Road, applicant/accused was found in possession of 2 kilograms of Poppy Husk, without any permit or license on the basis of secret information. Accordingly, applicant-accused was arrested on 02.08.2020 and since then he is in custody. Hence, this bail application.

4. As per the case of prosecution, accused-applicant was found in possession of 2 kilograms of Poppy Husk without any permit or license on 02.08.2020. The contraband recovered from applicant-accused is non-commercial quantity. At this stage the applicant-accused is in custody since 02.08.2020. No useful purpose would be served by detaining the accused/applicant in judicial custody for an indefinite period. The presentation of challan in Court and trial thereof will take sufficient long time. As such, the accused/applicant is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail /surety bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of learned Illaqa / Duty Magistrate, subject to the conditions that accused/applicant will appear in Court on each and every date of hearing and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

5. In view of prevailing circumstances and as per directions of Hon'ble High Court, applicant-accused is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- before concerned Jail Superintendent for the time being and he is further directed to furnish personal / surety bonds when the situation becomes normal in respect of

Covid-19 before the concerned Illqua / Duty Magistrate. Illaqa Magistrate /Jail Superintendent are further directed to send the said bonds to this Court within 10 days after accepting the same. Bail application stands allowed accordingly. Copy of this order be sent to the learned Illaqa / Duty Magistrate and concerned Jail Superintendent. Record be returned and bail file be attached with remand papers, if any, otherwise consigned to the record room.
