The application for bail U/s.483 of BNSS, filed by the accused petitioner as named above is taken up for hearing.

Heard the Ld. lawyer for the accused petitioner and the Ld. P.P., Murshidabad.

The Ld. Advocate for the present accused petitioner submits that the accused petitioner is in custody since 12.03.2026. He further submits that it is a case of suicide by the deceased. The marriage to place more than 8 years back. He prays for releasing the accused on bail.

It is also submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the accused petitioner that no such application for bail on the selfsame cause of action has ever been filed before or rejected by the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta, to which, the Ld. P.P. expressed his agreement.

Ld. P.P., Murshidabad strongly opposes the prayer for bail and submits that there are materials against the accused person. He points at the 183 statement of the child of the deceased and submits that the evidence indicate commission of murder of the deceased by the petitioner.

Perused the T.C.R. and the C.D.

It is found from the C.D. that Chare sheet has been submitted in this case for the offence punishable U/s.108/85/3(5) of BNS.

The Post Mortem examination report, lying with the C.D. indicates suicidal nature of death of the deceased. The child of the deceased, whose statement has been recorded U/s.183 of BNSS, is found to be of six years only.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case and the materials on record as well as the period of detention of the accused petitioner in custody, I am inclined to allow the prayer for bail.

Accordingly, the prayer for bail stands **allowed**.

The above named accused petitioner, in connection with above referred P.S. case may find bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of Rs.5,000/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the Ld. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Murshidabad.

Return the T.C.R. and the C.D.

The Crl. Misc. Case is thus disposed of.
