The record is put up today on the basis of a put up petition filed on behalf of the accused person, namely, ***Mithun Mondal @ Bishu.***

Ld. P.P.-in-Charge is present. So does the Ld. Defence Counsel.

Ld. Defence Counsel files the web copy of CRM (NDPS) No.:- 80 of 2025 dtd. 06.03.2025 coupled with an affidavit for the genuineness of the document and submits that the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta has been pleased enough to grant bail U/S 439 Cr.P.C. corresponding to Section 483 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in favour of the accused person.

Perused the copy of order of the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta Passed in C.R.M.(NDPS) No. 80 of 2025 dated 06.03.2025.

On perusal of the order of the Hon'ble High Court, passed in C.R.M.(NDPS) No. 80 of 2025 dated 06.03.2025, I find that the Hon'ble High Court has been pleased enough to grant bail u/s 439 of Cr.P.C. corresponding to Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, in favour of the accused person by passing the following order :-

“Accordingly, we direct that the petitioner, namely, ***Mithun Mondal @ Bishu*** shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs. 25,000/- with two sureties of Rs. 12,500/- each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the Learned Judge, Special Court (under the NDPS Act), Murshidabad, Baharampore subject to the condition that the petitioner shall remain within the jurisdiction of the Sainthia Police Station and shall meet the Inspector-in-Charge, Sainthia Police Station, twice a week until further orders and on further condition that the petitioner shall not leave the territorial jurisdiction of the districts of Murshidabad and Birbhum except for the purpose of attending court proceedings.

The petitioner shall appear before the trial Court on every date of hearing until further orders and shall not intimidate the witnesses and/or tamper with evidence in any manner whatsoever.

In the event the petitioner fails to adhere to any of the conditions stipulated above without justifiable cause, the trial court shall be at liberty to cancel the petitioner's bail in accordance with law without further reference to this court.”

In view thereof, the accused person is permitted to furnish bonds in terms of the order of the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta.

Let the server copy of the order of the Hon'ble Court be kept with the record.
