“ Hence,

O R D E R E D

That the application registered as MV Case 52 of 2005 is allowed on contest against the OP – 2 National Insurance Co Ltd and dismissed against the owner of the offending vehicle/OP1.

The OP/Insurance Company is directed to pay ₹ 675,000/to the claimant-petitioner within two months of this day along with interest at the rate of 6% per annum from the date of filing the instant application till the realisation of the award.

The payment is to be made by account payee cheque drawn in favour of the claimant-petitioner bearing the interest component.

A copy of this judgment is to be given to the OP/Insurance Company free of cost, for due compliance. Free copy may also be given to the claimant-petitioner upon her paying the full court fee, if not already paid in the meantime”.
