The application for bail U/s.483 BNSS filed by the petitioner as named above is taken up for hearing.

It is also submitted by the Ld. Defence Advocate that there is no order of rejection of prayer for bail by the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta or by this Court in respect of the present accused petitioner to which the Ld. P.P., Murshidabad expressed his agreement.

Ld. P.P., Murshidabad has cited the Medical documents, as available in the C.D.

Perused the FIR and other materials in the C.D.

The present accused petitioner is the husband of the victim lady and their marriage was solemnized 17 years back.

It is the allegation that the accused petitioner physically assaulted the victim lady and tried to asphyxiate her by throttling, he kicked on her lower abdomen and the victim lady was rescued by the local people.

Considered the O.P.D. patient card of the victim Tahera Bibi, as cited by the Ld. P.P., Murshidabad as available in the C.D. .

Considering the same and the period of detention of the accused in custody since **28.05.2026**, it appears that further custodial detention of the present accused petitioner will not serve any substantial purpose for the investigation.

Accordingly, the prayer for bail stands allowed.

Accordingly, the accused petitioner as named above in c/w the above noted P.S. case, shall be released on furnishing bail bond of Rs.3,000/- with two sureties of Rs.1,500/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the Ld. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Murshidabad.

The Crl. Misc. Case is thus disposed of.
