The application for anticipatory bail U/s.482 BNSS filed by the petitioners as named above is taken up for hearing.

Heard the Ld. lawyer for the accused petitioners and the Ld. P.P., Murshidabad.

Ld. Advocate for the accused petitioners has submitted that the dispute is purely Civil in nature.

Ld. Defence Counsel has submitted that no such application for bail on the selfsame cause of action has ever been filed before or rejected by the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta and no such application for bail has ever been filed before or rejected by this Court, to which, the Ld. P.P. expressed his agreement.

Ld. P.P., Murshidabad has raised strong objection to the prayer for anticipatory bail by citing documents that the entire land had already been transferred in the year 1985.

Perused the F.I.R. and other materials in C.D.

The matter arises on the basis of allegation of double selling of the land in plot no. 2572.

Considered the total quantum of land available at plot no. 2572.

Considered who sold the land and also considered the allegation against the accused persons.

Considering the same, I do not find it fit for granting anticipatory bail to the present accused petitioners.

Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail stands **rejected**.

The Crl. Misc. Case is thus disposed of.
