The application for bail U/s.483 BNSS filed by the petitioner as named above is taken up for hearing.

Heard the Ld. Counsel for the accused petitioner and the Ld. P.P., Murshidabad.

Ld. Defence Counsel has submitted that the accused petitioner is in custody since 24.05.2026 and considering the period of his detention, he may be enlarged on bail.

Ld. Defence Counsel has submitted that no such application for bail on the selfsame cause of action has ever been filed before or rejected by the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta, to which, the Ld. P.P. expressed his agreement.

Ld. P.P., Murshidabad has submitted that seizure have been made under Seizure lists dated 23.05.2026 and 26.05.2026.

Perused the FIR and other materials in the C.D.

This is a case inter alia U/S 25(1)(a)/35 of Arms Act.

Considered the nature of allegation made and the said Seizure lists dated 23.05.2026 and 26.05.2026.

Considering the same and the period of detention of the present accused petitioner in custody since **24.05.2026**, it appears to me that further custodial detention of this particular accused petitioner will not serve any substantial purpose.

In view of above, the prayer for bail stands **allowed**.

Accordingly, the accused petitioner as named above in c/w the above noted P.S. case, shall be released on furnishing bail bond of **Rs.5,000/-** with two sureties of **Rs.2,500/- each**, subject to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Murshidabad.

The Crl. Misc. Case is thus disposed of.
