The application for anticipatory bail U/s.482 of BNSS in respect of accused petitioner No.3. Biswajit Mondal @ Biswajit Mandal stands **rejected** being **not pressed**.

The application for anticipatory bail U/s.482 of BNSS filed for the petitioner **No.1 and 2**, as named above is taken up for hearing.

Heard the Ld. lawyer for the accused petitioners and the Ld. P.P., Murshidabad.

Ld. Advocate for the accused petitioners submits that the alleged incident took place as there was property dispute between the complainant and the accused persons.

It is also submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner that no such application for bail on the selfsame cause of action has been filed before or rejected by Hon'ble Court or by this Court, to which, the Ld. P.P. expressed his agreement.

Ld. P.P., Murshidabad has raised objection to the prayer for anticipatory bail and submits that the Injury report has been received.

Perused the TCR and C.D.

Perused the Injury report which says that the injury is simple in nature and does not really support the allegation of the complainant of being struck by hasua.

Considering the above facts, I do not find any necessity for custodial detention of the present accused petitioner No.1 and 2.

Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail in respect to the present accused petitioner **No. 1 and 2**, stands **allowed**.

Accordingly, in the event of arrest of the petitioner **No. 1 and 2**, as named above in c/w the above noted P.S. case, they shall be released on furnishing bail bond of Rs.5,000/- each with two sureties of Rs.2,500/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the arresting officer.

If released on bail, the petitioner **No. 1 and 2** are directed to comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 482(2) of BNSS.

Return the T.C.R. and the C.D.

The Crl. Misc. Case is thus disposed of.
