This is an application for bail U/s.483 BNSS for the accused petitioner Alamin Sk. @ Alamin Mondal.

It is submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner that no such application for bail on the selfsame cause of action has ever been filed before or rejected by the Hon'ble Court, Calcutta or by this Court, to which the Ld. P.P., Murshidabad expressed his agreement.

Ld. P.P., Murshidabad opposes the prayer for bail.

I have heard all the sides including the Defacto complainant.

I have gone through the materials in T.C.R. and the C.D.

The written complaint suggests omnibus overt act against the present accused.

The victim of such alleged act has suffered an apparently non-serious injury.

He was discharged from the O.P.D.

The accused petitioner is in custody since **23.04.2026**.

Considering all these aspects of the matter, I am inclined to enlarge the accused petitioner on bail.

Accordingly, the prayer for bail stands **allowed**.

The accused petitioner as named above, in c/w the above noted P.S. case, shall be released on furnishing bail bond of Rs.4000/- with two sureties of Rs.2,000/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the Ld. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Murshidabad.

T.C.R. & C.D. be returned.

The Crl. Misc. Case is thus disposed of.
