The application for anticipatory bail U/s.482 BNSS filed by the petitioner as named above is taken up for hearing.

Heard the Ld. lawyer for the accused petitioner and the Ld. P.P., Murshidabad.

Learned Counsel for the accused person submitted that he has no knowledge that total 10 ferry ghat out of 19 ferry ghat were allotted in his name by the Prodhan of Ghoramara Gram Panchayet. Ld. Counsel further submitted that in fact, this accused petitioner is the victim of the offence. Ld. Counsel submitted that when the Hon'ble Court recorded the submission of Panchayet Samity that Executive Officer was acted inappropriately in allotting 19 ferry ghat, then this BDO lodged the FIR to safe his own skin. Ld. Counsel submitted that in fact this accused petitioner never received any single paise or collected any money from the ferry ghat at any point of time.

Ld. Defence Counsel has also submitted that no such application for bail on the selfsame cause of action has ever been filed before or rejected by the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta, the Ld. P.P. expressed his agreement.

Ld. P.P., Murshidabad strongly opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail by referring the materials in C.D.

Perused the FIR and materials in case record and the C.D.

According to the FIR this accused petitioner operated 10 ferry ghats without any valid sanction by using fake document and thus misappropriated Rs. 23,90,000/-.

Considered the statements of the witnesses. Considering the same, it appears that this is not a fit case for granting anticipatory bail.

In view of above, the prayer for anticipatory bail stands **rejected**.

The Crl. Misc. Case is thus disposed of.
