Order No.02 dated 30.06.2026

The application for anticipatory bail U/s.482 BNSS filed by the petitioners as named above is taken up for hearing.

Heard the Ld. lawyer for the accused petitioners and the Ld. P.P., Murshidabad.

Ld. Defence Counsel has submitted that no such application for bail on the selfsame cause of action has ever been filed before or rejected by the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta and no such bail application is pending before or rejected by this Court, to which, the Ld. P.P. expressed his agreement.

Ld. P.P., Murshidabad has raised objection to the prayer for anticipatory bail by citing the injury report in respect of alleged injured namely Sagora Bibi as available in the C.D.

Perused the F.I.R. and other materials in C.D.

Considered the statement of the alleged injured victim cum complainant U/s.180 of BNSS.

Also considered the OPD patient card in respect of another alleged injured.

Considering the facts and circumstances, materials in the C.D. and the nature of injury, it appears to me that custodial detention of the present accused petitioners will not serve any substantial purpose for the investigation.

Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail stands **allowed**.

Accordingly, in the event of arrest of the petitioners as named above in c/w the above noted P.S. case, they shall be released on furnishing bail bond of **Rs.5,000/- each** with two sureties of **Rs.2,500/- each**, subject to the satisfaction of the arresting officer on condition to meet with the I.O. **once in a week** till completion of investigation.

If released on bail, the petitioners are directed to comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 482(2) of BNSS.

The Crl. Misc. Case is thus disposed of.
