Order No.04 dated 17.07.2026

The application for anticipatory bail in respect of the present accused petitioner **No.9. Popi Bibi @ Ahida Bibi** stands **rejected being not pressed** as per the endorsement made by the Ld. Advocate on the application U/s.482 of BNSS.

The application for anticipatory bail U/s.482 BNSS filed in respect of the petitioner **No.1 to 8 and 10 and 11** as named above is taken up for hearing.

It is also submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner that no such application for bail on the selfsame cause of action has ever been filed before or rejected by the Hon'ble Court, Calcutta or by this Court, to which, the Ld. P.P. expressed his agreement.

Ld. P.P., Murshidabad has cited page **No.10, 27 and 29** of the C.D.

Perused the FIR and other materials in the C.D.

Considered the nature, type and size of injury and other information mentioned in the Injury report coupled with the statement of the witnesses U/s.180 of BNSS as cited by the Ld. P.P., Murshidabad as available in C.D.

After considering the same, it appears that custodial detention of the present accused petitioners **No.1 to 8 and 10 and 11** will not serve any substantial purpose for investigation.

Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail U/s.482 of BNSS in respect of accused petitioners **No.1 to 8 and 10 and 11** stands **allowed**.

In the event of arrest of the accused petitioners **No.1 to 8 and 10 and 11** as named above in c/w the above noted P.S. case, they shall be released on furnishing bail bond of Rs.5,000/- each with two sureties of Rs.2,500/- each, subject to the satisfaction of arresting officer on condition that the accused petitioner **No.1, 3, 4, 5, 7 and 11** shall meet with the I.O. **once in a week** till completion of investigation.

If released on bail, the petitioners **No.1 to 8 and 10 and 11** are directed to comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 482(2) of BNSS.

The Crl. Misc. Case is thus disposed of.
