The application for bail U/s.483 of BNSS, filed by the petitioner as named above is taken up for hearing.

Heard the Ld. lawyer for the accused petitioner and the Ld. P.P., Murshidabad.

The Ld. Advocate for the present accused petitioner submits that the accused petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case by her husband and his family members in order to create a shield for the case of dowry demand and torture which the petitioner could file against them as she was driven out from her matrimonial house. He also submits that the petitioner have a child in her lap and prays for releasing the accused on bail.

It is also submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner that no such application for bail on the selfsame cause of action has ever been filed before or rejected by the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta, to which, the Ld. P.P. expressed his agreement.

Ld. P.P., Murshidabad submits that the injured was admitted at Murshidabad Medical College and Hospital for one day.

Perused the T.C.R. and the C.D. including the OPD emergency ticket of Saktipur BPHC and discharge certificate of Murshidabad Medical College and Hospital.

It appears that no serious injury is caused to the injured.

Having regard to the nature of allegations and the materials appearing on record, there appears no necessity of further detention of the female accused for the purpose of investigation.

Accordingly, the prayer for bail stands **allowed**.

The above named accused petitioner, in connection with above referred P.S. case may find bail on furnishing bail bond of **Rs.4,000/-** with two sureties of **Rs.2,000/- each**, subject to the satisfaction of the Ld. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Murshidabad on condition to keep herself available for interrogation by the I.O. at all reasonable times till submission of charge sheet.

Return the T.C.R. and the C.D.

The Crl. Misc. Case is thus disposed of.
