

Order no 34, dt 01.06.2026

Today is fixed for hearing of bail petition of accused Kawsar Ali who is in J/C.

Ld. PP in charge and Ld. Defence counsel are present.

The bail petition is taken up for hearing.

Heard both sides.

Ld. Advocate for the accused submits that the accused person is innocent and he was previously on bail but due to miscommunication he could not appear before the Court for which W/A was issued against him on the basis of which the accused was arrested and produced before this Court on 22.05.2026 and since then he is in custody. He also submits that he will appear before the court on each and every date of hearing to be fixed and therefore, he may be released on bail on any condition.

Ld. PP in charge left the matter to the discretion of this Court.

Perused the materials on record.

It appears from the record that the accused person was previously on bail but he has misused the liberty of bail. However, taking into consideration the period of detention, I think that the accused has realised the consequence of misuse of bail and he may be released on interim bail.

Accordingly, the bail prayer of accused Kawsar Sk is allowed.

The accused **Kawsar Sk** may find **interim bail** of Rs.5000/- with two sureties of Rs. 2,500/- each, other than the previous surety, subject to the satisfaction of Ld. ACJM, Lalbagh, Murshidabad till date i.e. 24.07.2026.

To date i.e. 24.07.2026 for appearance, if on **interim bail**.

The accused person must be present on the date fixed.
