The application for anticipatory bail U/s.482 BNSS filed by the petitioners as named above is taken up for hearing.

Ld. Defence Counsel has submitted that the accused persons have been falsely implicated in this case.

It is also submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the petitioners that no such application for bail on the selfsame cause of action has been filed before or rejected by Hon'ble Court or by this Court, to which, the Ld. P.P. expressed his agreement.

Ld. P.P., Murshidabad has cited page No.30 and 50 of the C.D.

Perused the FIR and other materials in the C.D.

Considered the page No.30 (Recovery memo) and 50 (statement of the victim girl U/s.183 of BNSS) as cited by the Ld. P.P., Murshidabad, as available in C.D.

After considering the statement of the victim girl U/s.183 of BNSS, I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the present accused petitioner **No.1. Naim Sk. @ Naim Aktar**.

In view of the above, prayer for anticipatory bail of the present accused petitioner **No.1. Naim Sk. @ Naim Aktar** stands **rejected**.

With regard to the accused petitioner **No.2 & 3**, after considering the nature of materials appearing from the C.D. against them, I am of the view that custodial detention of accused **No.2 & 3** will not serve any substantial purpose for the investigation.

Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the accused petitioner **No.2 & 3** stands **allowed**.

Accordingly, in the event of arrest of the present accused petitioner **No.2 & 3** as named above in c/w the above noted P.S. case, they shall be released on furnishing bail bond of Rs.5,000/- with two sureties of Rs.2,500/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the arresting officer on condition that the accused petitioner **No.3** shall meet with the I.O. **once in a week** till completion of investigation.

If released on bail, the **No.2 & 3** are directed to comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 482(2) of BNSS.

The Crl. Misc. Case is thus disposed of.
