The application for anticipatory bail U/s.482 BNSS filed by the petitioners as named above is taken up for hearing.

It is submitted by the Ld. Defence Counsel that the present petitioners have been implicated in this case on false and exaggerated allegation.

Ld. Defence Counsel has submitted that no such application for bail on the selfsame cause of action has ever been filed before or rejected by the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta or by this Court to which, the Ld. P.P. expressed his agreement.

Ld. P.P., Murshidabad has cited page **No.28, 31, 32** of the C.D.

Perused the materials in case record and the C.D.

Considered the statement of the victim at page **No.7 and 32** of the C.D.

Considered the page **No.28** and the impression.

There are **deep laceration** in the injury reports of both the injured victims on vital part of the body.

One fracture injury has also been detected.

After considering the statement of the witnesses U/s.180 of BNSS, I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail in respect of present accused petitioner **No.2. Eja Sk. @ Ejabul Sk.**

Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the present accused petitioner **No.2. Eja Sk. @ Ejabul Sk.** stands **rejected**.

With regard to the accused petitioner **No.1. Manirul Sk.**, after considering the materials against him, I am of the view that custodial detention of accused petitioner **No.1. Manirul Sk.** will not serve any substantial purpose for the investigation.

Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the accused petitioner **No.1. Manirul Sk.** stands **allowed**.

Accordingly, in the event of arrest of the petitioner **No.1. Manirul Sk.**, in c/w the above noted P.S. case, he shall be released on furnishing bail bond of Rs.5,000/- with two sureties of Rs.2,500/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the arresting officer on condition to meet with the I.O. **once in a week** till completion of investigation.

If released on bail, the petitioner **No.1. Manirul Sk.** is directed to comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 482(2) of BNSS.

The Crl. Misc. Case is thus disposed of.
