The application for bail for the above named accused petitioner U/s.483 of BNSS is taken up for hearing.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the accused petitioner and the Ld. P.P., Murshidabad.

Ld. Defence advocate has submitted that in this case Charge sheet has already been submitted and the accused petitioner is in custody since 26.05.2026.

It is also submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the accused petitioner that no such application for bail on the selfsame cause of action has been filed or rejected by Hon'ble Court, to which the Ld. P.P. expressed his agreement.

Ld. P.P., Murshidabad has raised objection to the prayer for bail.

Perused the materials in case record and the C.D.

In this case Charge sheet has been submitted and other accused petitioners are already on bail.

I have gone through the F.I.R., the statement of witnesses U/s.161 of Cr.P.C. including the Injury report.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case including the fact that Charge sheet was submitted long back and also considering the period of detention of the accused in custody since **26.05.2026**, I am of the view that further detention of the present accused petitioner in custody will not serve any fruitful purpose.

Accordingly, the prayer for bail U/s.483 BNSS stands **allowed**.

Hence, the above named petitioner, in connection with above noted P.S. case, shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.5000/- with two sureties of Rs.2,500/- each, subject to the satisfaction of Ld. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Murshidabad.

The Crl. Misc. case is thus disposed of.
