The application for bail for the above named accused petitioner U/s.483 of BNSS is taken up for hearing.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the accused petitioners and the Ld. P.P., Murshidabad.

It is also submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the accused petitioners that no such application for bail on the selfsame cause of action has been filed or rejected by Hon'ble Court, to which the Ld. P.P. expressed his agreement.

Ld. P.P., Murshidabad has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Perused the T.C.R. and the materials in C.D.

I have carefully perused the F.I.R. and other materials in case record and the C.D., including the statement of the witnesses including that of the alleged victim U/s.180 of BNSS and the Injury report.

Nature of injury, as per the Injury report, is simple.

It further transpires that some other co-accused persons, standing on same footing with the present accused petitioners, are already on bail.

In view of above aspects and also the period of detention of the accused petitioner in custody since **02.06.2026**, I am of the opinion that further custodial detention of the present accused is not necessary for the purpose of investigation.

Accordingly, the prayer of the petitioner for bail U/s.483 BNSS stands **allowed**.

The above named petitioner in connection with above noted P.S. case, with regard to the incident complained of, shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.5000/- with two sureties of Rs.2,500/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the Ld. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Murshidabad.

The Crl. Misc. case is thus disposed of.
