The application for bail U/s.483 BNSS filed by the petitioners as named above is taken up for hearing this day on the strength of put-up petition, filed on behalf of the present accused petitioners.

It is submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the petitioners that no such application for bail on the selfsame cause of action has ever been filed before or rejected by the Hon'ble Court, Calcutta to which, the Ld. P.P. expressed his agreement.

It has been submitted by Ld. P.P. that the stolen motorcycle has been recovered and there is no scope for further improvement in the investigation.

The accused petitioners are in custody since 27.05.2026.

The above named accused petitioners, in connection with above referred P.S. case may find bail on furnishing bond of **Rs.6,000/- each** with two sureties of **Rs.3,000/- each**, subject to the satisfaction of the Ld. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Murshidabad.
