The application for anticipatory bail U/s.482 BNSS filed by the petitioner as named above is taken up for hearing.

Ld. Defence Counsel has submitted that this accused petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and considering the same, he may be granted anticipatory bail.

Ld. Defence Counsel has also submitted that no such application for bail on the selfsame cause of action has ever been filed before or rejected by the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta and no such bail application is pending before or rejected by this Court, to which, the Ld. P.P. expressed his agreement.

Ld. P.P., Murshidabad submits that the victim lady was not treated at any hospital and there is no Medical document in the C.D.

Perused the F.I.R. and other materials in C.D.

Considered the F.I.R.

The marriage of the victim lady with the present accused petitioner was solemnized 15 years ago.

Considered the statement of the alleged victim lady U/s.180 of BNSS at page **No.19** of the C.D., as cited by the Ld. P.P., Murshidabad.

There is no Injury report in the C.D.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, it appears to me that custodial detention of the present accused petitioner will not serve any substantial purpose.

Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail stands **allowed**.

Accordingly, in the event of arrest of the petitioner as named above in c/w the above noted P.S. case, he shall be released on furnishing bail bond of Rs.5,000/- with two sureties of Rs.2,500/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the arresting officer.

If released on bail, the petitioner is directed to comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 482(2) of BNSS.

The Crl. Misc. Case is thus disposed of.
