The application for anticipatory bail U/s.482 BNSS filed by the petitioner as named above is taken up for hearing.

Ld. Defence Counsel has submitted that the accused petitioner has been implicated on false allegation.

Ld. Defence Counsel has also submitted that no such application for bail on the selfsame cause of action has ever been filed before or rejected by the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta and no such bail application is pending before or rejected by this Court, to which, the Ld. P.P. expressed his agreement.

Ld. P.P., Murshidabad raises objection to the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Perused the F.I.R. and other materials in C.D.

According to the F.I.R., the brand name of M/S Freewill Sports Pvt. Ltd. (Nivia) has been misused and the accused person was distributing duplicate sports goods, infringing the copyright of above company.

Considered the F.I.R., lodged by S.I Abdul Jarjish Jafarul Alam, DEB Murshidabad P.D.

Considered the Seizure list.

Search and seizure have been done.

Considering the nature of offence, it appears to me that custodial detention of the present accused petitioner will not serve any substantial purpose.

Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail stands **allowed**.

Accordingly, in the event of arrest of the petitioner as named above in c/w the above noted P.S. case, he shall be released on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of Rs.5,000/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the arresting officer on condition to meet with the I.O. **once in a week** till completion of investigation.

If released on bail, the petitioner is directed to comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 482(2) of BNSS.

The Crl. Misc. Case is thus disposed of.
