The accused is in custody since 05.06.2026.

The accused husband has been enlarged on bail on 12.06.2026.

Ld. P.P., Murshidabad submits with fairness that there is no legal reason to detain the present accused petitioner when the principal accused husband has been enlarged on bail.

Considering all of the above, I deem it fit to allow the prayer for bail.

Accordingly, the prayer for bail stands allowed.

The accused petitioner as named above in c/w the above noted P.S. case, shall be released on furnishing bail bond of Rs.4,000/- with two sureties of Rs.2,000/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the Ld. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Murshidabad.
