**ORDER BELOW EXHIBIT NO.1****(Dated 06.08.2026)**

1. This is an application under Section 503 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023. To hand over possession of vehicle seized by Washim Rural Police Station, Tq. & Dist. Washim in Crime No.143/2026. According to applicant, officials of Washim Rural Police Station have seized his vehicle i.e. two wheeler Pulsar 150 DTS-I bearing Registration No.MH-37-X-6080 Engine No. DHYCJC11026, Chasis No. MD2A11CY0JCC14251. Due to seizure of the above vehicle his earning is stopped and he is facing problems to earn bread and butter. Moreover, he contended that the spare parts of his vehicle are diminishing due to its non use and impact of dust and heat as the vehicle is kept at police station. Thus, he prayed to hand over the vehicle to him.

2. Perused the say of Investigating Officer. I.O. had not specifically mentioned that, he has any objection or not. Learned APP submitted that, as the said vehicle is used by accused in above said crime its repetition in similar type of offence by the accused cannot be ruled out. Lastly she prayed for rejection of application.

3. Needless to say that, the seized two wheeler Pulsar 150 DTS-I bearing Registration No.MH-37-X-6080 Engine No. DHYCJC11026, Chasis No. MD2A11CY0JCC14251 is used to earn the daily needs of the applicant. The apprehension as pointed by the investigating officer can be saddled by imposing certain conditions on the applicant. Applicant has filed on record the verified copy of Registration Certificate, Vehicle Particulars, Copy of F.I.R., and Adhar card of applicant. No one has claimed the seized vehicle except the applicant. In such circumstances, this is fit case to release the

vehicle. Hence, I proceed to pass the following orders.

ORDER

1. The application is allowed.
2. The investigating officer is directed to release the seized vehicle two wheeler Pulsar 150 DTS-I bearing Registration No.MH-37-X-6080 Engine No. DHYCJC11026, Chasis No. MD2A11CY0JCC14251, seized in Crime No.143/2026 of Washim Rural Police Station, Tq. & Dist. Washim, be given to applicant Santosh Rameshwar Bhoyar, R/o Wangi, Tal. Dist.Washim, on executing indemnity bond for Rs.50,000/- (in words Fifty thousand) in the Court on following conditions,
 - a) The applicant shall not alienate, transfer or change the nature of the above mentioned vehicle till disposal of the case.
 - b) He must produce the vehicle as and when required by any police station or Court.
 - c) The applicant should not make use of the vehicle for any commission of crime of similar nature.
3. The PSO, Washim Rural Police Station, Tq. & Dist. Washim, is hereby directed to take the colored photographs of vehicle and prepare detail panchanama of releasing the vehicle in the custody of the applicant.
4. The Investigating Officer is further directed to submit the panchanama of releasing the vehicle in the custody of applicant with charge-sheet.
5. Office is directed to attach this record and proceeding along with final report of present Crime register.
6. The application is disposed-off accordingly.
