The application for anticipatory bail filed by the petitioner in connection with the above-noted case is taken up for hearing in the presence of the learned Advocate for the petitioner as well as the learned Public Prosecutor.

At the time of hearing learned advocate for the accused petitioner submits that the victim lady has got married with the accused and she is now living at her matrimonial home. He further submits that this is not a case of kidnapping and abduction of the victim lady and files some documents in respect of marriage between the victim and the accused person.

Also heard Learned Public Prosecutor who submits that there is nothing in the CD regarding the documents produced by the accused person.

On perusal of the materials on record, I find that this is a case of kidnapping and it is alleged that the accused person along with other co-accused had kidnapped the victim lady.

I am of the view that the documents submitted by learned counsel for the accused person should be verified by the IO.

Let the documents be sent to IO for verification and report.

Fix **09.07.2026** for hearing of the application for anticipatory bail and report of IO.

Call for CD along with report of IO regarding the documents submitted by the accused person.

Let a copy of this order be sent to IO of the concerned P.S. for his information and necessary compliance.
