The application for bail filed by the accused/petitioner in connection with the above-noted case is taken up for hearing in the presence of the learned Advocate for the petitioner as well as the learned Public Prosecutor.

Learned Advocate for the accused/petitioner moves the prayer for bail.

At the very outset, it is submitted that no bail application in respect of the present matter has been filed, is pending, or has been disposed of or rejected by any higher forum.

The learned Public Prosecutor concurs with the said submission.

The learned Advocate for the accused further submits that the present accused petitioner is in custody since 08.06.2026 and nobody was injured in the alleged incident. He prays for bail.

The learned Public Prosecutor has submitted that in the incident nobody sustained injury and nothing has been recovered during P.C. of this accused.

I have gone through the instant bail application and the materials available in case record as well as in C.D. including the seizure list and find that the accused petitioner was taken to P.C. but nothing was recovered at the instance of the accused petitioner during the P.C. period.

In the incident no injury was suffered by anybody.

The accused petitioner is detaining in J.C. since 08.06.2026.

So, at this stage further detention of the accused in custody is not required.

Hence,

ORDERED

The accused/petitioner named above shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bail bond of ₹ 3000/- with two sureties of ₹.1,500/- each, to the satisfaction of the Learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Berhampore, Murshidabad on condition to meet with the I.O. **once in a week** until further order or till submission of Charge sheet, whichever is earlier.

Return the T.C.R. and the C.D.

The Crl. Misc. Case is thus disposed of.
