Order No.04 dated 30.07.2026

The application for anticipatory bail U/s.482 BNSS filed by the petitioners as named above is taken up for hearing.

This day petitioners file a petition praying for necessary correction of Sections mentioned in the bail application.

Heard Ld. Advocate for the petitioners.

Perused the petition. Considered. The petition filed by the petitioners is allowed.

Accordingly, Sections mentioned in the Memo of bail application being U/S 109(1)/118(2)/3(5)/85 of BNS, 3/4 of D.P Act is **corrected as U/S 109(1)/118(2)/3(5)/85 of BNS, 3/4 of D.P Act and Adding Section 103(1) of BNS.**

Note in the relevant register. Necessary correction be made in the CIS.

Now the application for anticipatory bail U/s.482 BNSS filed by the petitioners as named above is taken up for hearing.

Heard the Ld. lawyer for the accused petitioners and the Ld. P.P. Murshidabad.

Ld. Defence Counsel has submitted that the marriage between the deceased victim and her husband was solemnized 08 years ago. It is further submitted that there is delay in lodging the F.I.R. when the alleged incident took place on 26.05.2026 and the F.I.R. was lodged on 28.05.2026. He further submitted that these accused petitioners are in-laws of the deceased victim and the husband of the deceased victim is in custody since 05.06.2026. These accused petitioners are in-laws of the deceased and they were living separately from the deceased victim.

Ld. Counsel for the accused petitioners has also submitted that no such application for bail on the selfsame cause of action has ever been filed before or rejected by the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta and no such bail application is pending before or rejected by this Court, to which, the Ld. P.P. expressed his agreement.

Ld. P.P. Murshidabad has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail by citing the dying declaration of the deceased available at page no. 83 in the C.D. and the statement of the witnesses available at page nos. 13 to 16 of the C.D.

Ld. Advocate for the defacto complainant has appeared by filing Vakalatnama and petition of objection and has raised objection to the prayer for bail.

Perused the FIR and the materials gathered in the C.D.

According to the allegation and according to the materials available in C.D. it transpires that the husband developed extra marital affair and their matrimonial life is more than 07 years old.

Considered the dying statement of the deceased victim found at page no. 83 in the C.D. and tone of the said statement.

Also considered the statement of the witnesses available at page nos. 13, 14, 15 and 16 of the C.D.

Considering the nature of allegation and materials against the husband and the present accused petitioners, it appears that husband and other accused petitioners are not in the same footing.

The husband of the deceased victim is in custody since 05.06.2026.

In view of the above, it appears to me that custodial detention of the present accused petitioners will not serve any substantial purpose for the investigation.

Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail stands **allowed**.

Accordingly, in the event of arrest of the petitioners as named above in c/w the above noted P.S. case, they shall be released on furnishing bail bond of **Rs.10,000/- each** with two sureties of **Rs.5,000/- each**, subject to the satisfaction of the arresting officer.

If released on bail, the petitioners are directed to comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 482(2) of BNSS.

The CrI. Misc. Case is thus disposed of.
