The application for anticipatory bail U/s.482 BNSS filed by the petitioners as named above is taken up for hearing.

Heard the Ld. lawyer for the accused petitioners and the Ld. P.P. Murshidabad.

Ld. Defence Counsel has also submitted that no such application for bail on the selfsame cause of action has ever been filed before or rejected by the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta and no such application for bail has ever been filed before or rejected by this Court, to which, the Ld. P.P. expressed his agreement.

Ld. P.P., Murshidabad opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail by citing the documents available at page nos. 4 & 6 in the C.D.

Perused the FIR and other materials in the C.D.

Ld. Defence Counsel draws the attention of the Court to some documents in support of his submission regarding previous Civil dispute between the parties vide Misc. (LR) case no. 34/2026, which is pending before Ld. Civil Judge (Jr. Div.), 1st Court, Jangipur, Murshidabad where the mother of the victim is the defendant. Let the same be kept with the record.

Considered the said documents i.e. one Misc. (LR) case no. 34/2026 and the statement of the mother of the victim.

Considering the nature of allegation made and the materials in C.D. and nature of the case, it appears that custodial interrogation of the present accused petitioners will not serve any substantial purpose for investigation.

Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail stands **allowed**.

Accordingly, in the event of arrest of the petitioners as named above in c/w the above noted P.S. case, they shall be released on furnishing bail bond of **Rs.10,000/- each** with two sureties of **Rs.5,000/- each**, subject to the satisfaction of the arresting officer with direction to meet the I.O. **once in a week** till completion of investigation.

If released on bail, the petitioners are directed to comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 482(2) of BNSS.

The Crl. Misc. Case is thus disposed of.
