Makhan Lal vs. State BA 143

Heard. Allegations against the accused are that he is habitual to fill empty gas cylinders from the filled gas cylinders in his old house situated at Jain Hospital street, Raman and he sold the cylinders in black by taking full price of cylinder but putting less quantity of gas in it. He has no permit or licence to sell the cylinders. Even while doing so, he caught fire and received fire injuries on his body. Fire was controlled by public. If the fire was not controlled then heavy loss of life and money could have taken place. On these allegations, case u/s 420, 336 IPC and 7 EC Act was registered. The criminal liability of accused under these sections cannot be ascertained at this stage. The offences are triable by the Court of magistrate. Nothing is to be recovered from the accused-applicant. The accused is not required for any custodial interrogation. Without commenting on the merits of the case in hand, the applicant/accused Makhan Lal is ordered to be released on interim anticipatory bail in the sum of Rs.80,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer, Police Station, Raman, subject to the conditions that the applicant/accused shall join the investigation as and when required by the Investigating Officer, he shall not leave the country without prior permission of the Court and the accused/applicant shall not threaten or induce any witness to dissuade them from disclosing the true facts. Now file be put up on 31.1.2019 for awaiting the outcome of investigation.
