Order No.02 dated 08.07.2026

The application for anticipatory bail U/s.482 of BNSS filed by the petitioners as named above is taken up for hearing.

Heard the Ld. lawyer for the accused petitioners and the Ld. P.P., Murshidabad.

Ld. Advocate for the accused petitioner submits that there is a counter case, pending against the complainant party and they have been granted bail by the Ld. A.C.J.M., Lalbagh, Murshidabad.

It is also submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the petitioners that no such application for bail on the selfsame cause of action has been filed before or rejected by Hon'ble Court or by this Court, to which, the Ld. P.P. expressed his agreement.

Ld. P.P., Murshidabad has raised objection to the prayer for anticipatory bail.

This day the T.C.R. is not available before this Court.

Perused the F.I.R. and other materials in C.D. and the Injury report.

It appears from the C.D. that there is dispute between the parties involving land which had given rise to the alleged incident.

However, the Injury report mentions multiple injuries on left ear and on the parietal region of head of the victim.

The C.D. does not show any substantial development in investigation since 08.06.2026.

In view of above, it appears that custodial detention of the present accused petitioners is not required for the purpose of investigation.

Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail stands **allowed**.

Accordingly, in the event of arrest of the petitioners as named above in c/w the above noted P.S. case, they shall be released on furnishing bail bond of Rs.5,000/- each with two sureties of Rs.2,500/- each, subject to the satisfaction of the arresting officer on condition that the present accused petitioner **No.1, 3, 4 and 6** shall meet with the I.O. **once in a week** until further order or till completion of investigation, whichever is earlier.

If released on bail, the petitioners are directed to comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 482(2) of BNSS.

Return the C.D.

The Crl. Misc. Case is thus disposed of.
