ORDER:-

1. An application for bail under section 482 of BNSS has been filed on behalf of applicant in case FIR no. nil, under Section nil, P.S City-2, Khanna.

2. Upon notice, Additional Public Prosecutor appeared on behalf of State and the status report from the concerned police station was called.

3. I have heard the Ld. counsel for the applicant and Ld. Addl. Public Prosecutor for the State and have gone through the report.

4. The status report from the Police Station City-2 Khanna has been received wherein it has been reported that in the above-mentioned complaint, Kashmir Giri has alleged that he has been harassed by the police and that FIR No. 147 dated 18.09.2025 under Sections 21, 61 and 85 of the NDPS Act, Police Station Doraha, was falsely registered against him. It is submitted that in FIR No. 147 dated 18.09.2025 under Sections 21, 61 and 85 of the NDPS Act, Police Station Doraha, Kashmir Giri was nominated as an accused on 26.09.2025. On the same day, he was arrested by the police in accordance with law, and 50 grams of heroin was recovered from his possession. Thereafter, on 01.10.2025, he was lodged in Central Jail, Ludhiana. The said case has no connection with this police

station. Accused Kashmir Giri has seven criminal cases registered against him at different police stations. He is also a quarrelsome and habitual offender. Owing to his conduct, no person is willing to come forward to record a statement against him.

5. On the basis of report received from Police Station City-2 Khanna it has been found that the applicant has a criminal past history. As many as seven FIRs have already outstanding against him in different police station including Police Station City-2 Khanna. The applicant has also admitted in para no.3 of his bail application that he has already been nominated in FIR no.147 dated 18.9.2025 for the alleged offence punishable under Section 21 of NDPS Act, lateron added with another offence punishable under Section 27A of NDPS Act. Although, the same has been registered under Police Station Doraha. This application has been filed by the applicant on the basis of misrepresented fact by proclaiming that the police of Police Station City-2 Khanna is trying to implicate him in the FIR no.147 whereas the said FIR has been registered at P.S Doraha. All these facts show that the applicant cannot be held entitled blanket anticipatory bail. Therefore, his bail application is found meritless and same is hereby dismissed. The applicant is at liberty to seek is remedy as provided under the Law. Bail application be consigned to the record room.
