

N.D.P.S. Case No. 101/2026

Order No. 4, dated 24.07.2026.

Accused Janarul Islam @ Jana is produced from PC in connection with Raninagar PS Case No. 383/2026 dated 15.07.2026 u/s 21(c)/29 of the NDPS Act. He makes no complaint regarding his health. He is taken into custody and remanded to JC till 03.08.2026.

Received the PC accused challan, forwarding letter, medical papers, nil seizure list dated 23.07.2026, seizure list dated 23.07.2026 and a prayer for inventory. Perused the documents. Let the documents be kept with the record.

Ld. Special Public Prosecutor and Ld. Remand Advocate for the accused person appointed from the DLSA are present.

A petition for bail is also filed and moved on behalf of the accused person.

Ld. Remand Advocate for the accused person prays for bail of the accused person.

Ld. Special Public Prosecutor raises objection against the prayer for bail.

Heard the rival submissions at the Bar. Considered.

Perused the case record.

Considering the nature and gravity of the offence, early stage of investigation and bar u/S. 37 of the NDPS Act, prayer for bail of the accused person is rejected.

At this stage, Ld. Advocate Mr. Meheub Alam Biswas appears and he files a vokalatnama in respect of the accused person. Let it be kept with the record. However, no bail petition is filed by him for the accused person.

I.O. is present with CD.

I.O. has filed a petition praying for production of accused Rajesh SK @ Titu SK and Minmay Mondal before this Court for their further police remand.

Ld. Special P.P. submits that prayer of the IO may be allowed for the interest of investigation of this case.

Ld. Advocate for the accused person raises vehement objection.

Considering the fact that prayer for PC in respect of accused Rajesh SK @ Titu SK and Minmay Mondal has been allowed by this Court vide order dated 15.07.2026 and during PC period no contraband substance was recovered, prayer of the IO for production of the accused persons, namely Rajesh SK @ Titu SK and Minmay Mondal for their further police remand is rejected.

I.O. has made a prayer for authentication of the inventory as per Section 52A(2) of the N.D.P.S. Act and for disposal of the said petition.

The prayer of the I.O. is considered and allowed u/S. 52A (3) of the NDPS Act.

The record be placed before the Id. J.M., Lalbagh, Murshidabad to prepare inventory during the course of which, 100 bottles of Codeine Phosphate and Triprolidine Hydrochloride Syrup, Eskuf (Cough Syrup) of 100 ml. each, alleged to have been seized, shall be put up before the Magistrate, the bottles of contraband substance shall be counted, photograph shall be taken and representative sample of the seized articles shall be collected by the I.O. The Id. Judicial Magistrate shall certify the same and send report before this court by 10.08.2026.

The record be put up before Ld. J.M., Lalbagh, Murshidabad.

I.O. is directed to put up the seized articles before the Ld. J.M., Lalbagh, Murshidabad. I.O. is also directed to make necessary arrangement on the date, to be fixed by the Id. Magistrate, to get the inventory done.

The prayer for pretrial disposal of the seized alamats u/S. 52A (1) of the NDPS Act is allowed, but after completion of process of certification of correctness of inventory by the Ld. J.M. Thereafter the seized narcotic drug psychotropic substances controlled substances can be disposed of as per Section 52A(1) of the said Act retaining the certificate, photographs and samples as primary evidence as per Section 52A(4) of the NDPS Act, in the manner and following the procedure as has been provided u/S. 52A of the NDPS Act.

To date (03.08.2026) for production of the accused person and final report.

Let a copy of this order be sent to the Ld. J.M., Lalbagh, Murshidabad for information.

Let another copy of this order be supplied to the I.O. for information and necessary action.
