Report of HC Raju Kumar forwarded by SHO PS Jama Masjid is received. There is no date mentioned under the signatures of HC Raju Kumar as well as SHO PS Jama Masjid. Inspector Vishesh Kumar present in the court stated that he has forwarded the present report as the SHO is on leave.

As per report, FIR no. 297/2026 dated 29.06.2026 u/s 135/138/150 Electricity Act has been registered at PS Jama Masjid.

The SHO PS Jama Masjid was also asked to explain the reasons if action has not been taken on the complaint given on 10.06.2022 till date in compliance of circulars issued by office of Joint Commissioner of Police, Cenral Range, Delhi, dated 16.02.2026 and 26.02.2026. No explanation is found in the report filed today in this regard.

HC Raju Kumar present today stated that he is investigated the matter and he is asked to produce the case diary written by him qua the investigation conducted by him so far. He is not having the checklist required to be issued by the ACP upon registration of FIR under the instructions issued by the office of Ld. Commissioner of Police, Delhi vide Standing order 444/2016.

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The investigations in the matter are to be conducted in the monitoring of the DCP in compliance of Standing order no. 444/2016. The monitoring of the investigation by the Court is dispensed with and the file be clubbed with the final report as and when is filed before the Court.

Copy of the order be sent to the office of Ld. Commissioner of Police, Delhi for appropriate action to avoid the defeat of justice at the ends of his subordinates.
