Record is put up today by a put up petition filed on behalf of petitioner Nitya Gopal Mandal.

Ld. Advocate for the petitioner has filed another petition praying for release of the seized motorcycle. He has also filed xerox copy of certificate of registration of the seized motorcycle in favour of him being the rightful owner.

Ld. P.P. in-charge has raised objection. He has further submitted that the I.O. of this case filed report regarding return of seized motorcycle on 04.05.2023.
