The present application for regular bail has been filed on the ground that the applicant-accused has been taken into custody as he absented on the last date of hearing and surrendered himself. He could not appear due to illness and due to advance age. The medical certificates of treatment of same is placed on record. The accused was granted regular bail earlier and is regularly facing trial and never absented before. Under these circumstance, this Court finds sufficient reasons to allow the present bail application. The present bail application stands allowed and applicant-accused is ordered to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds to the tune of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in equal amount. Bail application stands disposed off. Papers be consigned to record room. Copy of bail order be attached with concerned filed.
