This is an application under Section 482 Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS) for grant of anticipatory bail moved by applicant/accused Rahul Kumar, through Ld. Counsel.

Briefly stated, the present FIR No.102/2026 had been registered on the basis of a complaint made by Sh. Sanjay Jagdish and other investors against M/s Duvera Retails Pvt. Ltd., its Directors namely, Bhoop Singh, Gaurav Verma and Sanjeev Sharma and other persons associated with the fraudulent investment scheme being operated under the guise of "FunTasteTic Cafe", wherein thousands of innocent investors were allegedly induced to invest their hard-earned money by

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promising fixed monthly returns and assured repayment under various investment schemes namely Micro Franchise, Mini Franchise, Macro Franchise and COCO Model.

It is the case of prosecution that during investigation, name of applicant/accused was disclosed by the main accused persons as one of their active associates who carried out the alleged offences in pursuance of criminal conspiracy. It is further the case of prosecution that during investigation, it was revealed applicant/accused figures amongst the Diamond Rank Associate of M/s Duvera Retails Pvt. Ltd. who had developed a substantial investor downline under the eight -tier MLM hierarchy.

It is argued by Ld. Counsel for the applicant/accused that the applicant/accused is himself one of the victims in the alleged ponzi scheme and induced by main accused persons Bhoop Singh, Gaurav Verma and Sanjeev Sharma who are directors of M/s Duvera Retails Private Ltd. It is argued that the applicant/accused is ready and willing to join the investigation and provide relevant documents necessary to aid the investigation.

Heard. Perused.

Considering the material on record, submissions made and guidelines of Hon'ble Supreme Court in case titled as ***Satender Kumar Antil v. CBI***, 2022 SCC OnLine SC 825, applicant/ accused **Rahul Kumar** is directed to join the investigation and subject to his joining and cooperating during investigation, IO is directed not to

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take coercive steps against **applicant/accused Rahul Kumar** till next date of hearing in the present case only.

Put up for further hearing on bail application as well as filing of status report by the IO on 17.08.2026.

Copy of the order be given 'dasti' to the Ld. Counsel for the applicant/ accused as well as IO as prayed.
