NDOH, after process of mediation.**

Both the parties are directed to appear before
mediation Centre on date and time already fixed.

It is clarified that if parties fail to appear before
the Mediation Cell on the date and time fixed, cost will be
imposed on the next date of hearing. Both the parties are hereby
directed to be present in the court on the next date of hearing for
recording of statement if the mediation succeeds and in case
mediation fails, parties shall appear before this court for the
purpose already fixed.

Ahlmad is hereby directed to send complete file to
the Mediation Cell well in advance.

Now to come up for report on settlement,
otherwise for furnishing of bail bonds and framing of NOA on
22.08.26.

Accused is directed to appear in person on the next
date of hearing.
